

**STOW-MUNROE FALLS ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB MEETING**

Ms. Bulgrin asked if there were any questions and thanked the Booster Club members for their attention. Mike reviewed that the Booster Club can endorse a levy. John Daymon motioned and Ed Ferencz seconded that we support the levy. All voted unanimously to do so.
