### **COACHES REPORT**

**Kimpton – Boys 8<sup>th</sup> grade basketball had an undefeated season. Girls are currently in a tournament. Track just started at Kimpto with 90 girls and 90 boys. There will be a track clinic on 3/29/08 at the high school.**

**Swimming – We sent 8 kids to states; 4 boys and 4 girls. Sadly Bart Kimble has resigned and we are in need of a new swim team coach.**

**Tennis – Girls won the NOC River Division. 6 of the 7 were named to the all NOC River team. We had 35 girls and made no cuts to the tennis squad. Thanks to the Boosters for the benches and t-shirts.**

**Track – Started on Monday.**

**Wrestling – We had a great year. Thanks to the Boosters and Cyle for your help and support. We sent 8 wrestlers to districts and 2 to states. Tim Darlington came in 8<sup>th</sup> in the State and had 103 wins in 3 years for the Bulldogs. Frank Saraniti came in 7<sup>th</sup> in the state and had a career of 110 wins for the Bulldogs. We have 9 returning letterman back for next year.**

**Bowling – We had Julie Trevanno finish 5<sup>th</sup> in districts and was 21 out of 114 in states.**

**Boy's Volleyball – We had a good turnout, enough to field a varsity, J.V. and maybe a freshman team. Prospects of the younger grades are very good!**

**Boys Lacrosse – New club sport with 34 boys signed up. The coach is volunteering currently. We have 15 games scheduled so far.**

**New Business: We had a guest speaker from Relay for Life. Stow Munroe Falls High School is the Host site for this year's relay for life which is May 31 – June 1<sup>st</sup> Stow and Hudson have been combined for several years. This year they will remain combined with Stow having their own next year. It's a 24 hour event. There are 45,000 relays across the country. Thanks to the boosters for allowing us to use the Booster Concession Stand (just the facility) for the teams to fundraise. The Stow/Hudson relay is the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest in the state and raises \$200,000 +.**

### **ATHLETIC DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

**Thanks to Val Bonacci and Dale Gaydos for helping to find and hire Scott Carter as the new girls Volleyball Coach.**

**We will also be hiring a new cheerleading and swimming/diving coach.**

**Currently working on future football schedule. Football generates 60% revenue to the Athletic Department. We have Massilon scheduled for 2009 and at Stow in 2010. We're trying to keep to 6 home games.**

**Thanks to Tom Harrell for attending meeting and handling Summer Sunset Blast (SSB). We will again sell French fries in the trailer. It a great community weekend and we made a lot of money last year. Val Bonacci will be looking for volunteers to work the booth for shifts over that Labor Day weekend for Sat. and Sunday.**

**Mike, Neil, Cyle and Tom Adams met with the architects at the high school to review blue prints for the new concession/bathroom building that will be located across from the bus garage near the high school. There will be a large concession stand (1/2 size of the field house) with 2 restrooms and a storage facility. We will have copies of the blue prints. Review it and offer suggestions and thoughts to the**

**building. Neil showed us an aerial view of the complex. The aesthetics should be similar to the baseball field.**

**Modern Building Supply has donated vinyl siding for the Press Box. Ruhlin has quoted siding it in order to be completed by the Fall.**

**Kim reported that a committee is finishing up drafts to the by-laws in order to present to the officers for review.**
